### 2 Background:

- Issue 1 of this Letter was released on 11 March 2005 to alert Jabiru owners and operators that the sealant then used in their fuel tanks was incompatible with fuels containing alcohol. Recommendations at the time were to use AVGAS or a suitable alcohol-free MOGAS.
- Subsequently new sealants were introduced and new guidance information is available to operators of Jabiru Aircraft in the form of Jabiru Service Letter JSL 007 (Issue 6 at the time of writing). That information supersedes and replaces the information given in Issue 1 of this letter.
- Accordingly, this Service Letter JSL 003 is CANCELLED and must not be referenced for maintenance.
