1. Applicability:

For the purposes of aircraft and engines operating under Australian Light Sport Aircraft categories, the following is a Manufacturer's Safety Directive.

All Jabiru engines in the serial number ranges given below:

- Jabiru 2200A model, Serial Number 22A1845 and above.
- Jabiru 2200B model. Serial Number 22B001 and above.
- Jabiru 2200C model. Serial Number 22C001 and above.
- Jabiru 3300A model. Serial Numbers 33A722 and above.
- Jabiru 3300L model. Serial/Numbers 33L722 and above.

2. Compliance Statement to ASTM Standard F2339-06:

This bulletin is to provide an official airworthiness statement relating to the compliance of Jabiru engines with the ASTM LSA Standard F2339-06. This bulletin also provides an official airworthiness statement relating to operating Jabiru Engines at night as required by ASTM Standard F2245-06.

This bulletin confirms that Jabiru engines in the Serial Number ranges above meet the requirements of ASTM Standard F2339-06 (Standard Practice for Design and Manufacture of Reciprocating Spark Ignition Engines for Light Sport Aircraft) when installed, operated and maintained in accordance with the design, performance and other applicable standards relevant to the category in which the engine is operating. In addition, the engines must be operated in accordance with the provisions, limitations and instructions of their applicable Jabiru approved publications & continuing airworthiness instructions.

3. Compliance Statement to ASTM Standard F2245-06:

ASTM standard F2245 for Design and Performance of a Light Sport Airplane was updated in 2006 to allow LSA's to operate at night in VFR conditions. To do this, there is now a
